Period 3: 11.15am – 12.15am

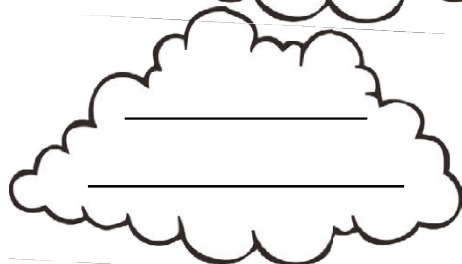
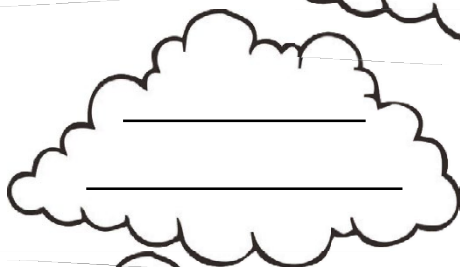
Period 4b: *Go to this lesson for half an hour, then you have lunch for half an hour, then you return back to your P4 lesson.*
