### Counting past 20

Put a hyphen between the **tens** and the **unit**  
e.g. vingt-deux (22)  
trente-trois (33)


The only numbers a bit different are 31, 41, 51 and 61.

These put "and" between the **tens** and **unit**

e.g trente et un (31)  
quarante et un (41)

**SFC (silent final consonant)**

If the last letter of a word is  
a consonant, it's silent.

grand gros petit

**Grammar:**

Remember that an adjectives  
changes to the **feminine**  
**spelling** when you are  
describing a **female** person.  
Unless it already ends in an **E**

**Top tip:**

Try linking your sentences together with some **connectives**

**et = and**

**aussi = also**

**ou = or**

**mais = but**

**Grammar:**

For feminine **singular** adjectives – add **E**

For masculine **plural** – add **S**

For feminine **plural** - add **ES**

If an adjective ends in an **X** you don't need to add an **S**.
