Grammar: Adjectival agreements

All nouns in French are either classed as **masculine** or **feminine**. Masculine nouns use the articles **un** [a] or **le** [the]. Feminine nouns use the articles **une** [a] or **la** [the]. Plural nouns use **des**.

Adjectives change to **agree** with the noun they are describing.

- Adjectives for **masc** nouns stay the same:

*Je mets **un** tshirt **bleu***

- Adjectives for **fem** nouns add an **e**:

*Je mets **une** jupe **bleue***

- Adjectives for **feminine plural** nouns add an **es**:

*Je mets **des** basket **bleues***
