Phonics:

-gne is pronounced 'nye'.



For example: 'montagne' is pronounced
'montanye'

Common Misconceptions

Y = there. In French this word needs to go BEFORE the verb, unlike in English where it is placed after the verb.

I'm going there = J'y vais
