

HT3: Qu'est-ce que tu vas faire? What are you **going to** do...?

Normalement [normally]	je fais de la planche à voile [I do windsurfing]
D'habitude [Usually]	je fais du cheval [I go horseriding]
De temps en temps [from time to time]	je nage [I swim] je joue à l'ordinateur [I play on the computer] je fais du camping [I go camping] je fais une balade du vélo [I do a bike ride]
Le week-end prochain [next week]	je vais [I'm going to]
L'année prochaine [next year]	on va [we are going to]
À l'avenir [in the future]	faire ... [to do...] nager... [to swim...] jouer [to play] manger... [to eat] aller [to go]

TOP TIP:

When using 2 tenses at the same time, remember the following.

For a basic **present** tense sentence about what we do, we just need one verb after *je*
Je joue – I play
Je fais - I do
Je nage – I swim

The **future** tense needs two verbs: the verb **aller** + an **infinitive verb**.

To say what **I'm going to do** use
Je vais + infinitive

Grammar

Infinitive verbs: An infinitive verb translates as **to do** something

e.g *jouer* = to play

finir = to finish

faire = to do

In French, you can spot an infinitive verb easily because it ends in **-er, -ir, -re**
