Learning the regular preterite tense

This tense is used for describing simple, completed actions in the past e.g. 'I ate, we drank, they talked'. It is formed as follows: Remove the infinitive ending and add:

-ar	-er / -ir
-é	-í
-aste	-iste
-ó	-ió
-amos	-imos
-asteis	-isteis
-aron	-ieron
