Is always pronounced like a **K** not **Kw**
quisiera **quiero** **quince**

This is pronounced like you are clearing your throat!
viajar **ojo** **jamón**

In Spanish, we use the subjunctive mood after cuando (when) to express a future event still to happen. Learn these set phrases to talk about what you are planning to do.

Other examples :

Cuando vayas a la estación, llámame

When you go to the station, Call me

Cuando sea adulto, me gustaría comprar una casa

When I am an adult, I would like to buy a house
