Grammar

Negatives: In Spanish, the negative structure **no** goes before the verb.

E.g.

No soy español
*I am **not** Spanish*

For any sentence with a direct object pronoun (D.O.P) **no** goes before D.O.P the and before the verb.

E.g.

No me escucha

No me permite salir
