Grammar

In Spanish we can miss out the pronouns for I (yo) you (tú), he (él) and she (ella) because the **end** of the verb changes depending on **who** is doing the action.

FOR –AR verbs

descansar		to relax
descanso	I relax	
descansas		you relax
descansa	he/she relaxes	

Some **irregular verbs** don't follow this pattern, you just have to learn them as you go.

IR	to go
voy	I go
vas	you go
va	he/she goes
