What are you **going to** do...?

**hago natación** [I go swimming]

**descanso** [I relax]

[next week]

[this weekend]

el año próximo

[next year]

**voy a**

[I'm going to]

**vamos a**

[we are going to]

**hacer ...** [to do...]

**jugar...** [to play...]

**sacar fotos** [to take photos]

**descansar...** [to relax]

**tomar el sol** [to sunbathe]

**escuchar...** [to listen...]

### Grammar

Infinitive verbs: An infinitive verb translates as **to do** something

e.g jugar = to play

ir = to go

comer = to eat

In Spanish, you can spot an infinitive verb easily because it ends in **-ar**, **-er**, **-ir**

When using 2 tenses at the same time, remember the following.

The **present** tense often ends in **O**  
**me llamo** - I'm called  
**juego** - I play  
**escucho** - I listen

The **future** tense needs the verb **ir**  
+ **infinitive verb**.

To say what **I'm going to do** use  
**voy a** + infinitive

To say what **we are going to do**  
use **vamos a** + infinitive

Notice that they both start with **V**

Let's think of it as the **Future**  
tense to remind to use **Voy a** or  
**Vamos a** + infinitive
