**Grammar**

In Spanish, we normally use the indefinite article ( a or an in English) before a **singular noun**. There is a **masculine** (un) and a **feminine** (una) indefinite article.

Any adjective describing a **masculine noun** must be **masculine** too.  
 An adjective describing a **feminine noun** must be the **feminine version**  
**E.G** Vivo en un pueblo turístico  
 Vivo en una ciudad turística
