Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: Year 6/7 Transition Days – Wednesday 8th July 2026 and Thursday 9th July 2026

I am delighted to be writing to you to confirm details of our transition days on **Wednesday 8th and Thursday 9th July 2026** for all Year 6 children joining us in September. Parents should make arrangements for travel to and from school, noting the school start and finish timings for both days. The Year 6 students will be participating in a variety of lessons over the two days so a pencil case with equipment would be recommended.

On Wednesday 8th July your child should report to main reception at Meadowhead School on Dyche Lane at **8:45am** where they will be met by a member of staff. One of the sessions will be PE so they should come to school dressed appropriately for taking part in sport. Unfortunately, they will not have an opportunity to change so must come dressed as advised. All children will receive a free school meal from our catering provider. They will be **released from school at 2:30pm**. They are welcome to bring their own packed lunch or snacks to eat during social times and should also have a water bottle.

Please arrange with your child whether they will make their own way home or whether you will collect them from Meadowhead School.

On Thursday 9th July your child should be at Meadowhead School for **8:45am**. Children should wear their normal Year 6 school uniform. Please note, blazers and ties will not be required if this is part of their Year 6 uniform. They will also need to bring a packed lunch on this day. If your child is eligible for free school meals, a meal will be provided. Children will be **released from school at 2:30pm**.

Again, please make arrangements for the end of the day with your child.

On Tuesday 14th July, please note there is a Parents' Evening from **6:00pm – 7:00pm** in the main school hall. Here you will meet key members of staff and learn more about the school's work. It will enable you to understand how best to support and prepare your child for life in Year 7 at Meadowhead.

Starting at **5:30pm**, prior to the main parents' evening, parents are welcome come along and meet the Special Educational Needs (SEN) team at Meadowhead. The SENCo will talk about what SEN support looks like at Meadowhead and what to expect in September. This is open to all parents but will only be relevant to those whose children have additional needs.

To ensure we are able to accommodate you all, we ask that only **one** parent/carer attends this meeting from each family.

Please do not bring your child/children with you as there will not be sufficient space in the hall for all parents/carers.

We look forward to welcoming your child to our fantastic school and seeing you at the Parents' Evening.
