The verb “aller”

Je vais	I'm going
Tu vas	you're going (sing.)
Il va	he's going
Elle va	she's going
Nous allons	we're going
Vous allez	you're going (pl.)
Ils vont	they're going (masc.)
Elles vont	they're going (fem.)

REMEMBER THE SONG!

The near future tense.

Uses present tense of “aller”+ infinitive tense
e.g.

Je vais
I'm going



jouer
faire
regarder
avoir
visiter
travailler

- Je vais jouer au foot - I'm going to play football
- Il va faire les devoirs - He's going to do his homework

Future tense time markers

La semaine prochaine = next week
Demain = tomorrow

A l'avenir = in the future

Le weekend prochain = next weekend

L'année prochaine = next year

Ce soir = tonight
