

COVID - 19 What Should I Do?



My child has symptoms

- High temperature
- New continous cough
- Loss or change to your sense of smell or taste



- Do not send your child to school
- Arrange for your child to have a PCR test and they must isolate until they receive their result.





POSITIVE RESULT

Your child must remain at home and isolate as per NHS guidance.

NEGATIVE RESULT Your child can return to school.

Members of the household have COVID-19 symptoms



- All household members advised to take a PCR test
- As long as your child does not have symptoms they can attend school whilst awaiting results.

Members of the household have tested positive for COVID-19



- All household members advised to take a PCR test within 48. hours
- As long as your child does not have symptoms they can attend school whilst awaiting results.
- It would be advisable to take a daily Lateral Flow Test before attending school for 5 days.

My child has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19



- It would be advisable for your child to take a PCR test and continue to attend school whilst waiting for the result
- As long as your child does not have symptoms they can attend school.

My child's friend in school has tested positive for COVID-19



- It would be advisable for your child to take a PCR test and continue to attend school whilst waiting for the result
- As long as your child does not have symptoms they can attend school.

My child has taken a lateral flow test and the result is negative



- Your child can attend school
