Strategy Statement

The fund provides additional funding for schools to help with the disruption to learning caused by coronavirus (COVID-19).

It's for small group tuition in English, maths and other courses where learning was affected, for example, vocational courses where assessment has been deferred because of lockdown.

It is our intention to spend the funding on teaching resources to support very small groups – Maths (3) English (1). These classes will be held in addition to the students curriciculum timetable. We will use existing teachers who will provide directed teaching time to support these students catch up on missed work through our lockdown period. We will take into consideration students needs and local circumstances to help them achieve level 4 grades and above.

The classes will be clearly defined, with their own teacher in a smaller classroom, conducive to smaller group activity.

The overall aims of our catch-up strategy is

- To reduce the attainment gap between disadvantaged pupils and their peers.
- To raise the attainment of all pupils to close the gap created by COVID-19 school closures.
- Ensure that students have positive levels of well-being and are confident they can achieve, despite the period of partial school closure.
