Drayton Manor Year 8 Reward Trip – Tuesday 18th July

This event aims to reward Year 8 students who meet consistently high standards during the summer term. To qualify, we require students **to have achieved a positive behaviour record between April and June 2023, to have good levels of attendance and punctuality, and to have consistently met the requirements of the school's code of conduct.**

The date of the trip will be **Tuesday 18th July 2023 at a cost of £30.50**. This includes the cost of entry to Drayton Manor, insurance and return transport. If you would like your child to attend the trip, please visit our online payment system <https://www.pay360educationpayments.com/> in order to provide your consent and make your payment by **Friday 17th June**. You will find the Drayton Manor trip under the 'Trips' heading.
