Dear Parent/Carer and Year 11 student

**Re: Remaining Year 11 examinations**

We recently contacted you to explain that study leave for Year 11 students will begin **at the end of the day on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2023**. All students are expected to be in school on Monday for the 8:35 warm up ahead of sitting the second English language paper. We would also ask that you support us in ensuring that your child remains in school until the end of the school day as all students will have their final science lessons in the afternoon ahead of the 2 remaining science papers. These lessons will provide students with important last-minute advice and resources.

From Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> June onwards, we still have 10 papers left to be taken. We expect all students with remaining examinations to arrive promptly for the warm up sessions ahead of their papers.

We are also providing booster sessions designed to give support and guidance shortly before a subject paper. All booster sessions will run between 11:15 and 12:15 after a morning core examination. If a student has an **afternoon examination that day, the booster is compulsory** and once again we ask for your support in reinforcing this at home with your child. We are also offering **recommended boosters** for students who have examinations on a different day .

The event will end about **5pm**.


The dress code is smart casual (e.g. jeans and a top, summer dress).
