- ✗ **No earphones or airpods in school**

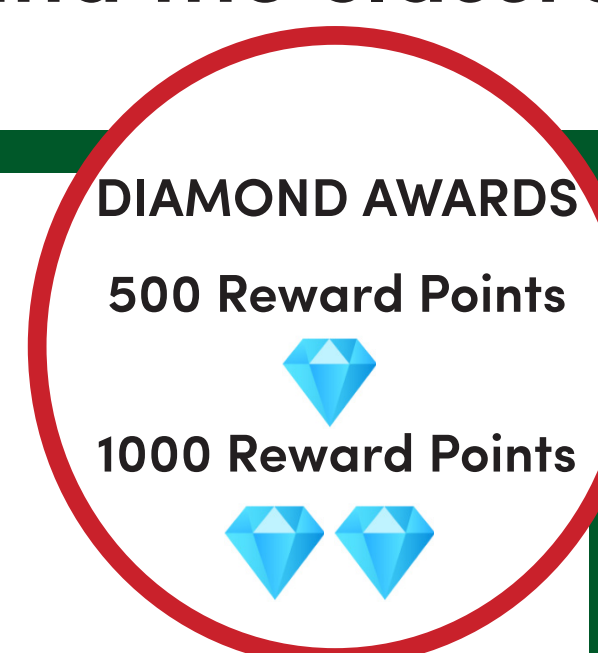


Rewards
