

KEY VOCABULARY

Mime - a drama convention of movement, gestures and expression to suggest character and/or action.

Mask Performance - wearing a mask to perform and using your body language, gestures and movement to communicate character and/or situation.

Exaggeration- being big and over the top.

Control - showing control over movement and positioning on stage

Gesture: An action or movement you do, usually with your hands

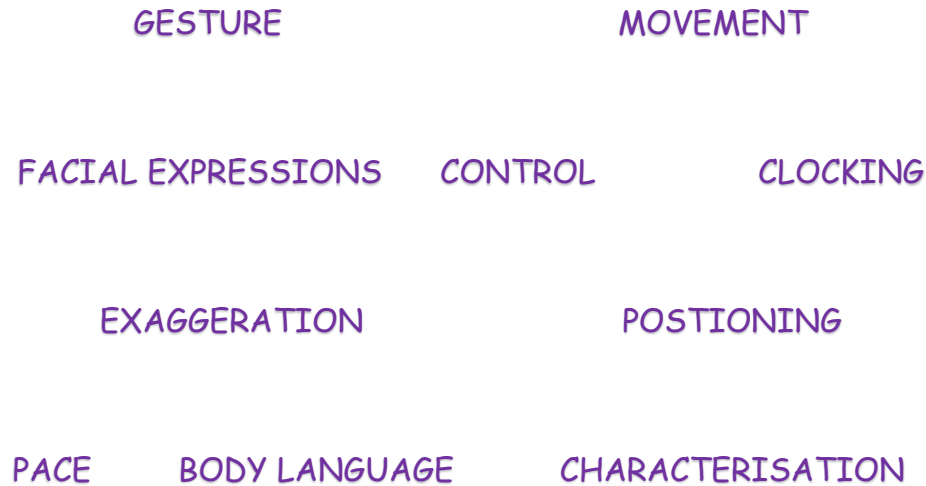
Movement: How you move your body on stage to play and show a character to the audience

Character - A role you perform, a person who is different from yourself

Mime and Mask performance is the use of movement to communicate character and action on stage. They are some of the oldest Drama Conventions in history

For the illusion...

Always put your back to the audience to put the mask on and take off

Don't touch the mask

Don't talk in the mask

For the performance...

Always face your audience

You must clock your audience.
