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Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: Uniform Expectations

As the Christmas break begins, we would like to give the following reminders about the school's "Smart, Safe and the Same" uniform and dress code policy ahead of students returning to school in January. We would ask that parents and carers consider carefully the school's expectations when booking appointments and making purchases over the holidays.

In particular, we would like to emphasise that:

- Students are only permitted a small stud (1cm or less) in both ears and in the nose. For safety, ear studs must be worn in the earlobe and not in the upper/outer ear. All piercings must be removed for PE. Other than a wristwatch, no other jewellery is permitted.
- Hair dye and braid colours can either be the school's colours of black or white, or a natural colour. Non-natural colours like blue, pink, purple and bright red are not permitted.
- Protective or religious hair and head coverings should either be all black or all white.
- Students may wear a waterproof outer coat for social times and transition around the building but hoodies, denim jackets and non-school jumpers are not permitted.
- Shoes should be black leather or leather look and have a hard outer shell.
- Skirts should be around knee length and worn with dark black tights to ensure safe and comfortable movement around school

To support this policy, non-permitted jewellery and other prohibited items will be confiscated "on sight". Any questions or concerns can be addressed to your child's year team and a full copy of the school's dress code can be found here: [Uniform/Dress Code](#)
