Dear Parent/Carer and Year 11 student

Re: Remaining Year 11 examinations

We are writing to you to explain our approach regarding the remaining GCSE examinations and the use of school-based preparation and home study opportunities for Year 11 students.

From Friday 5th June onwards, we still have 22 subject papers left to be examined.

The table overleaf summarises when examinations, warm up and booster sessions will occur for all remaining papers.

We expect all students with outstanding examinations to arrive promptly for the **compulsory warmup sessions** that we have arranged ahead of their papers, in their full school uniform.

We are also providing booster sessions designed to give support and guidance shortly before a subject paper. Most booster sessions will run between 11:15am and 12:15pm.

If a student has an **afternoon examination that day, the booster is compulsory** and we ask for your support in reinforcing this at home with your child.

These sessions not only provide helpful support, but ensure that all students are in the building in plenty of time ahead of their examination and are calm and ready to perform to the best of their ability.

We are also offering **recommended boosters** for students who have examinations on a different day.

If a student is not required to attend an examination, warm up or booster session, the expectation is that they are undertaking home study, in preparation for an upcoming paper, until all of their examinations are completed.

Prom and Record of Achievement Celebrations

We are looking forward to welcoming students back for Meadowhead's traditional end of Year 11 celebration event – the Record of Achievement - on **Tuesday 23rd June 2026**.

Students should return to school at around **2:50pm** and head to their form rooms.

This event will include the presentation of the Record of Achievement folder, speeches from student leaders and the Headteacher, t-shirt signing and photographs.

The event will end about **5:00pm**.

The dress code is smart casual (e.g. jeans and a top, summer dress).

Students should save their formal clothes for the Prom on **Friday 26th June 2026**. The prom begins at **6:45pm** and cars dropping off students will need to scan a QR code when they enter the carpark to avoid a charge. These will be issued by a member of staff towards the entrance of the hotel.
