Dear Parent/Carers,

Re: Cultures Day 2026 – Friday 3rd July

The school will be holding our second Cultures Day on Friday 3rd July. Building on last year's really positive and successful event, the day will aim to celebrate British and English culture alongside the cultures of other countries that are important in the lives and histories of Meadowhead students and their families.

During the day, students will be able to participate in the following:

- A bring and share form time activity: where students are able to volunteer to share a micro-presentation in form time on that morning (e.g. what British culture means to them, photos of a country that a student's family have moved from).
- Student volunteers will be arranging stalls that reflect the culture of specific countries during lunchtime.
- Students are invited to wear formal national dress or **accessories** that relate to countries that are important to them and their families. All Y7-Y10 students should either wear or bring uniform to school on that day (to allow them to change if needed). Accessories such as scarves, headbands, caps are permitted but football/sport shirts and tracksuits that cover up the uniform are not.

We would encourage families to support their child's preparation in this day; helping them to wear formal national dress or relevant accessory, encouraging them to volunteer to present to their form group or helping them to prepare a stall for the lunchtime displays. You might wish to share with your child, stories from your family's past or allow them to bring copies of photographs to display.
