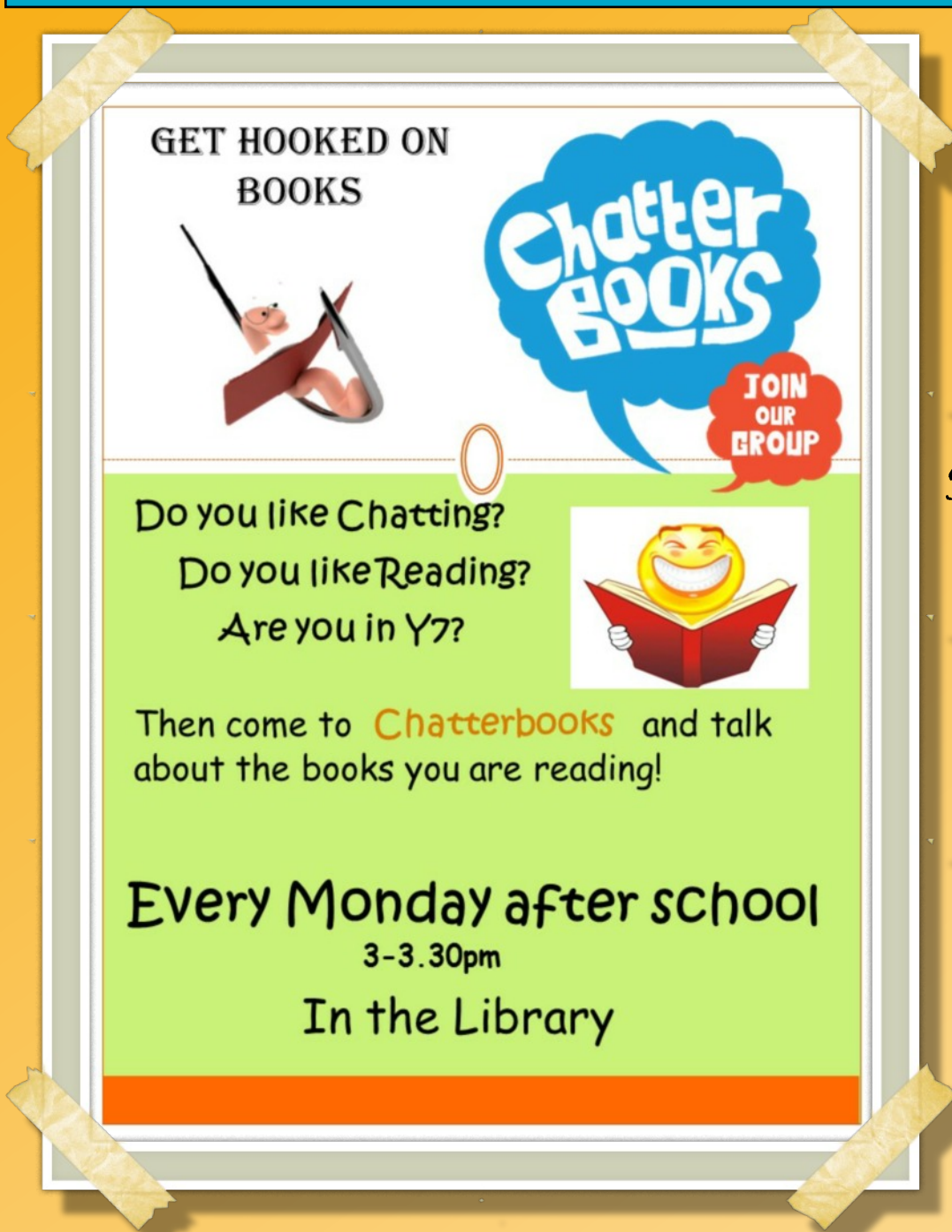

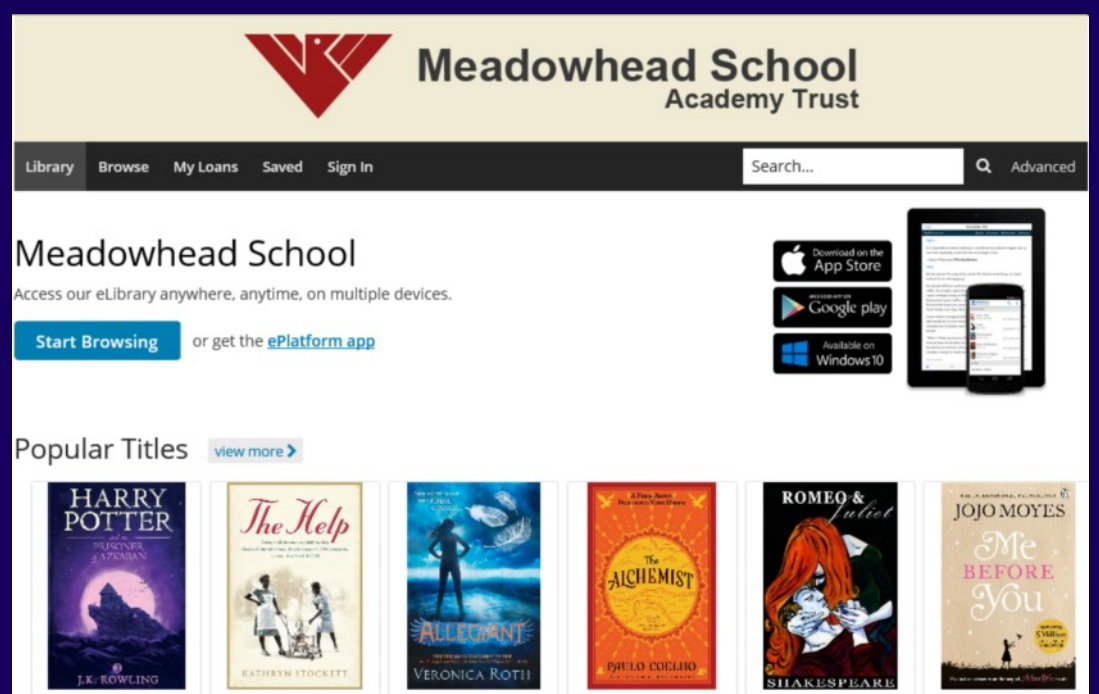
And borrow an e-bookAnywhere.....Anytime.....

On your ipad, Android device or Kindle Fire.

Students - just enter your usual school username and password - you can read it on your computer, Android device or ipad.

Borrow the book for 3 weeks just like a library book! (Some books are 2 week loans)

- read online or download to your tablet
- book is automatically returned at the end of the loan period
