RE: Year 11 Examination Preparation

As we approach the beginning of the summer examination process, we are writing to clarify a few very important points so that the process can be as smooth and stress-free as possible.

Passport to the PROM

We now have approximately 7 school weeks before the beginning of the summer examinations. Every year we launch our passport to the PROM programme to encourage students to fully engage in our examination preparation procedures. Students are asked to collect points towards their invitation to the PROM and have been given the following information:

The passport to the PROM runs for the 7 weeks between now and your exams beginning.

You have to have collected 70 positive points

You have to have fewer than 20 negative points

Positive Reward Points (R points) are awarded as follows;

R1 – For every day you attend school on time

R1 – For every homework you complete

R2 – For attendance at an after-school revision event

R2 – For a piece of additional revision work completed at home
(bring it to your teacher to see)

+ Additional rewards for meeting school expectations to a high standard

Negative Points (C Points) are awarded as follows;

C1 – For every late to school (8:30am)

C1 – For every late to lesson

C1 – For incorrect uniform

C1 – For missing homework

+ C1, C2, C3 points for poor behaviour, truancy and not meeting the school expectations

The R points can be tracked using the Classcharts app under the rewards heading.

VISA cards (After School Sessions)

All students have received a VISA card to enable them to track their attendance at the after-school sessions, and any revision work that they may complete at home. Teachers have recommended individual students to attend these sessions. The timetable is shown overleaf.

Students attending these sessions should come ready to fully participate in the activities arranged by their teachers.

Easter Revision Sessions

Many subjects will be offering Year 11 students the opportunity to attend revision sessions during the Easter holiday.

These events are by invite only as there is a great deal of organisation of staffing and resources required to ensure that the sessions benefit all those in attendance. Your child should speak to their class teachers if they have not received an invite and wish to be considered. Unfortunately, not all students can attend, but teachers will be able to provide revision materials to support your child over the Easter break via Classcharts.

Examination Study Leave

Your child may inform you that they only need to be at school when they have an examination. This is not the case. **All students should be in school, in full school uniform, until their last examination.** For most students this means that they will be in school until the end of their final science examination on the morning of Friday 12th June.

We wish all Year 11s the very best. We are here to support them and to ensure that they are fully prepared for their examinations. We wish them all good luck and encourage them to keep working hard.


