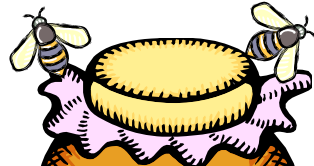

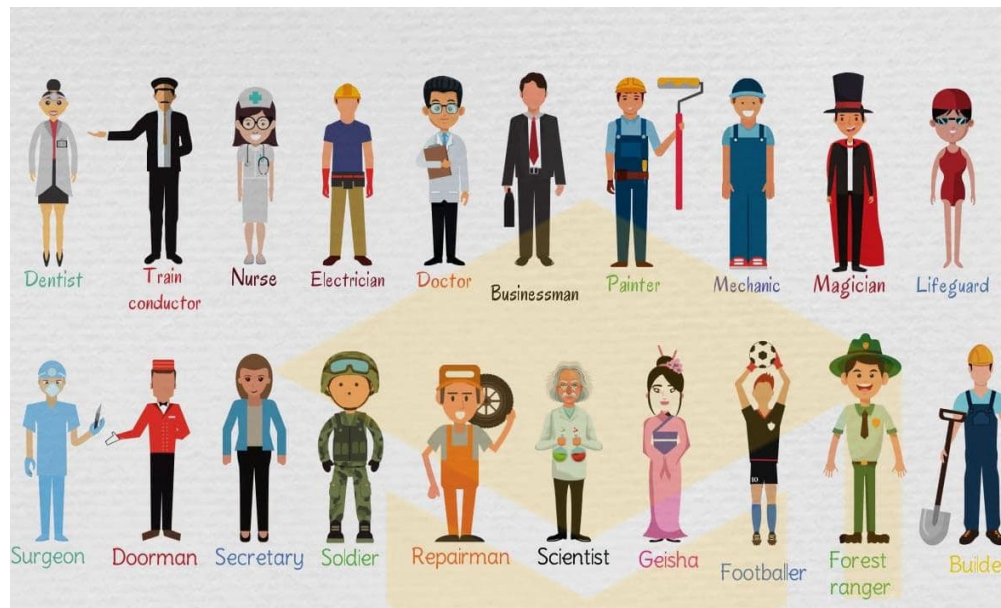

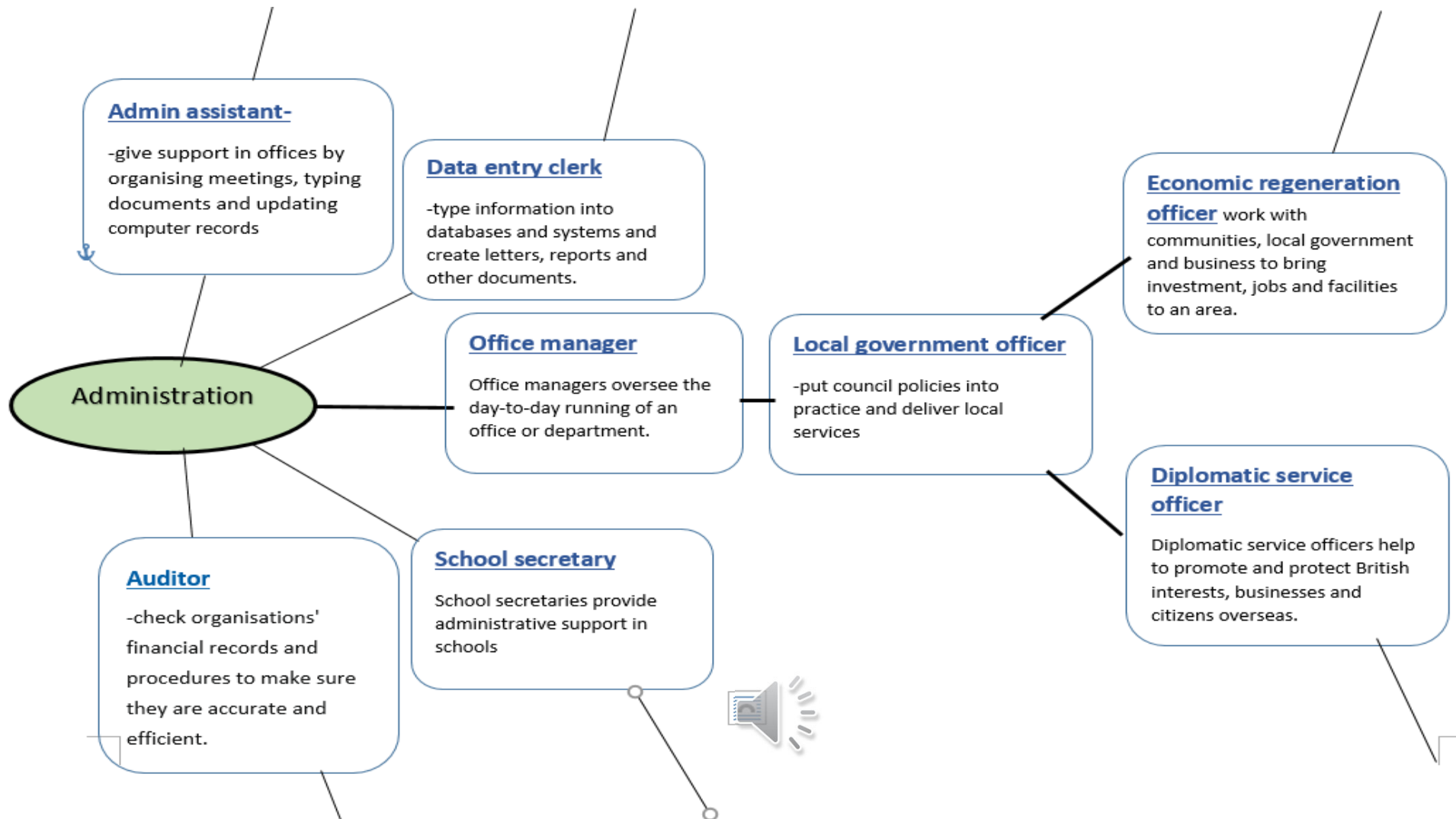

Future career planning and lifelong learning

- Maybe after this session you could do some research on Future careers that do not exist yet

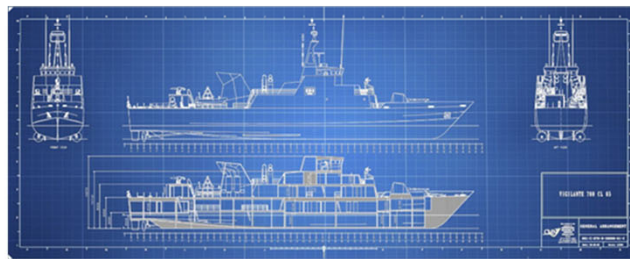
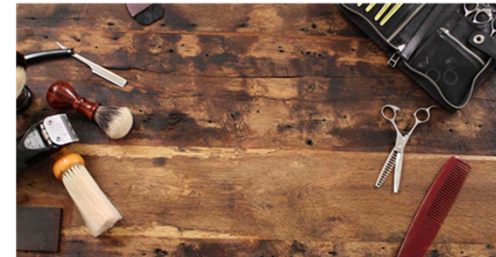

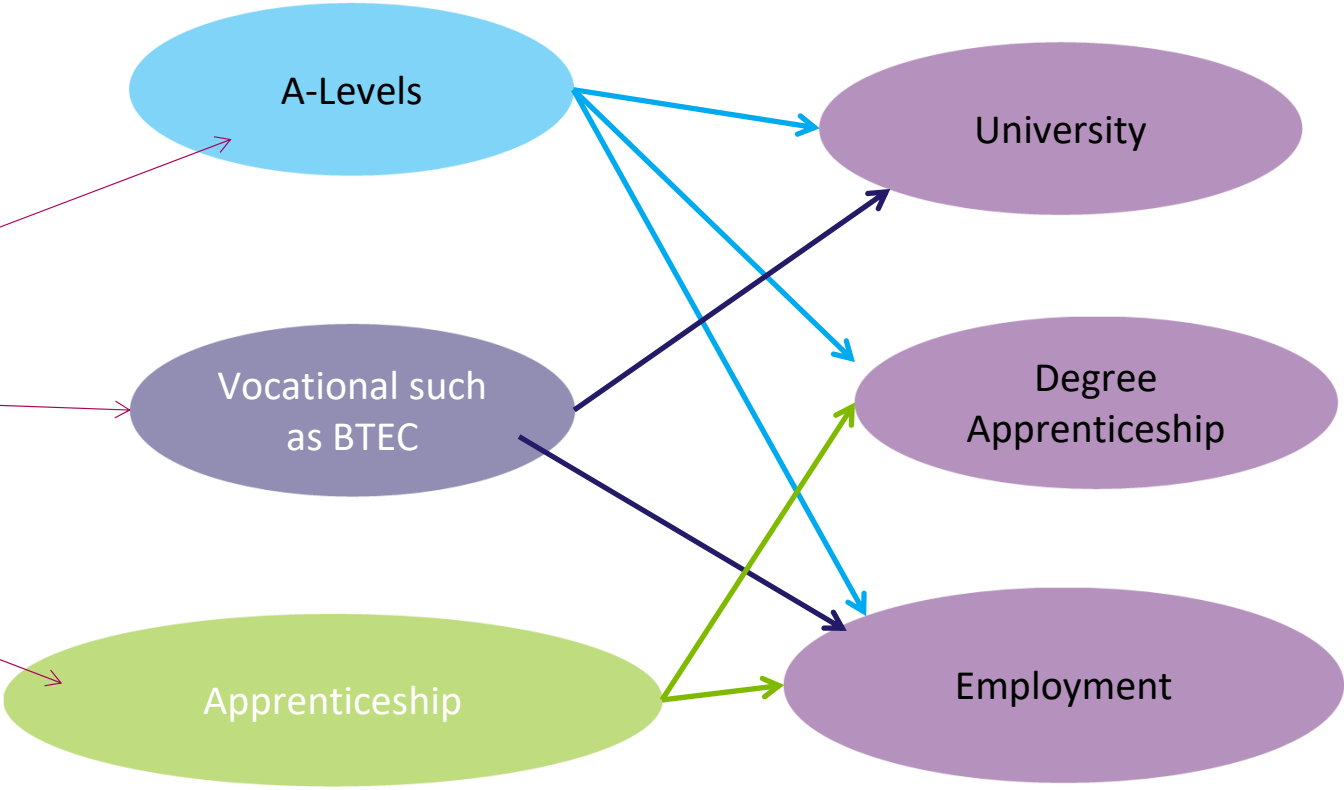
